

Guidelines for PITCA Library Users

The Pressing Iron and Trivet Collectors of America (PITCA) club maintains a library for its members under the care of Ken Broman in Duluth, Minnesota. Books and tapes may be borrowed for \$4.00. Magazines, journals, large pamphlets, and catalogs are \$3.00 each. Articles and small pamphlets are \$1.00 each. This fee is to pay for postage. Please make checks payable to Ken Broman.

Include the item number (#) from the PITCA Library Inventory when making your request. Send Ken the appropriate amount of money, and the items you wish to borrow will be sent to you. You may keep the items for two weeks. Please preserve the articles in good condition and pay the postage to send them back. If the items you want to borrow are already checked out, you will be informed and put on a waiting list.

If you have something to donate to the library, please feel free to do so. The Inventory will be updated periodically and new items included in issues of the club newsletter, "The Pressing News."

The PITCA Library Inventory is available in the Excel spreadsheet format. It can be sorted by any of the column headings, e.g., author, title, format, date. To download the PITCA Library Inventory, go to our club's website at www.pressingironandtrivetcollectors.org.
